This meeting was to discuss what is needed for the upcoming fete.

Disco (29th June) - All in hand, as previously discussed no tickets will be printed, as there is always a teacher present to mark off who has paid via ParentPay. Sophie unfortunately is away for the disco.

Where What You Like day (29th June) – Its felt that parents could pay £1 and we will then use that money for any extras we may need for the fete.

Mugs – These are intended for prizes for Welly Wanging etc. at the fete. Tracy has it in hand and the printer is awaiting Sarah for a cheque. Once the cheque has cleared it will take 3-4 day for printing and delivery. A few members queried the logo on the mug and wondered if we could add the words “what we nurture today flourishes tomorrow. Tracy checked this after the meeting and confirmed logo is printed twice on the mug and they cannot print on rim of the mug but there is no extra cost for extra printing.
