Progress Report

Cracker Game (Sophie) – there has been an issue with the cost of purchasing the crackers; price has gone from 0.09p each to 0.23p each. It was felt that this would not make enough of a profit. So with help from the other members Sophie would either make an advent calendar or baubles, with prizes on the back/doors.

Guess the weight of the Cake (Tracy) – has been made and iced ready to go. Tracy will need to do sheets for this only. In the event of 2 winners guessing the same weight then those names will go into a hat and winner drawn out.

Hook a Candy Cane (Sophie) – all done, just need to make bigger hooks.

Who's the Baby (Tracy) – This is in progress, although there are a number of teachers who still need to hand in photos. Have placed a deadline of 24th November. This will need to go out a week before the fair date and to be handed in and paid for on the 8th. Cost is £1 per go. Prize to be a national book token.

Tombolas (Keri) - Julie will send out letters to parents asking for bottles and prizes for these. Sophie will contact Western Cider and ask if they would be happy to donate.

Mulled Wine/Cider - depending on cost of purchasing wine or cider. There is a possibility we could sell this at the food stall. Gina/Helen to look at finding a possible donation.

Santa Keys (Julie) – On top of these and cost will be £1 each

Apples (Alyson) - To soon to do this. However, the local shop has kindly donated 9 bars of cooking chocolate to cover the apples. Cost to purchase apples at fair £1.

Lanterns (Alyson) – These are ready to go with handles already made and glued onto the jars. Cost to do £2 each

Reindeer Cones (Alyson) – All done cost £0.50p each

Face paints – will need to source more face paints. These are costly but it was felt that it would be worth it and we could always use them at the summer fete. However, we may leave it this time.

Putting Game (Chloe) - All done and in the school. Looks great.

Tin Game (Tracy) – All done and in the school. Kaylite (Snow) balls bought to throw at or into the tins. Prizes – 3 soft reindeer toys for the little kids and 3 boxes of chocolate for older kid/adults.
